- WHEREAS:** The State of Oregon is proud to join with the rest of the nation in honoring the dedication and professionalism of the women and men who are our Corrections Employees.

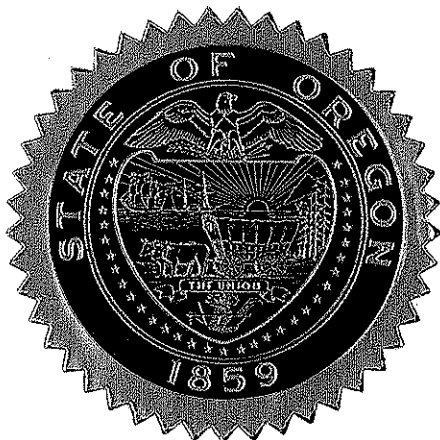
NOW,
